Training Modalities	Description
Previews and Demos	 Site specific, run and organized by on-site teams (i.e., Professional Practice) Training previews will be made available and demos set-up for employees to view Expanse Skills Days
eLearning	 e-Learning material created by Curriculum/Content Developer, Build Teams, and MEDITRAIN Accessed on CARE4 LMS CARE4 Trainers will be available to offer support to e-Learners via email/phone or during virtual office hours.
Instructor-led in person sessions	 Traditional in class training delivered by CARE4 Trainer or subject matter expert Sessions will be limited to the number of learners what can be in the training space based on COVID-19 restrictions.
Instructor-led in person labs	 Combination of hands-on learning and in-person training to compliment e-Learning These will be led primarily by CARE4 Trainers and occur on-site at each hospital.
Instructor-led Virtual Sessions	 Scheduled sessions on Teams led by a Trainer or subject matter expert to support end users with module specific training
Manuals, Tip sheets, FAQs, Videos	 Training materials created and posted within the LMS and intranet to support end user groups Required video content will be created using CARE4 resources led by the CARE4 Communications Lead
Drop-in Sessions or Virtual Office Hours	 Drop-in sessions will support employees who may have questions on a particular component of the solutions (virtual/in-person)
One on one sessions	 Elbow to elbow support for those employees who are struggling with other training modalities and Expanse. Most prominent during Go-Live
Self-Directed Learning - Practice activities	 Self-directed learning in the Expanse Training Environment staff will have access to navigate the Expanse System on their own for self-directed learning
Superusers	 Superusers are available to assist users with navigation of the Expanse system for 2 weeks after go-live - 24hrs/day
