- View Maverick on the Clinical Home Screen

- Document within the intake section
 - Confirm patient identification
 - Review allergies.
 - Document no known medications
 - AMB Triage Assessment:

- Document negative for COVID19 screening
 - Document a set of vitals
- Health Summary
 - Document the patient has a past medical history of Asthma
 - Document the patient has a family history of cardio vascular disease
 - Document the patient is living with spouse.
- Document in the specific section for each site.
 - RVH
 - Within the “**Surgical Treatment Clinic Note**” click on the section “**General Surgery Ax. & Tx.**” and document the appropriate fields for a carpal tunnel release
 - Assisted physician with procedure for carpal tunnel release.
 - R hand
 - Document a dressing has been applied.
 - Document patient tolerance
 - Document in the education and family teaching section
 - Document educational materials were provided and reviewed
 - HHCC
 - Within the “**Minor Procedures Note**” click on the section “**Nursing Documentation**” and document the appropriate fields for a carpal tunnel release
 - Assisted physician with procedure for carpal tunnel release.
 - R hand
 - Local Anesthetic used: Lidocaine 1% with epi used.
 - Document a dressing has been applied.
 - Document patient tolerance
 - GBGH

 - Appointment booking follows clinic specific processes (e.g., managed through the physician's community office OR patient sees clerk at end of the visit to book another visit)
