

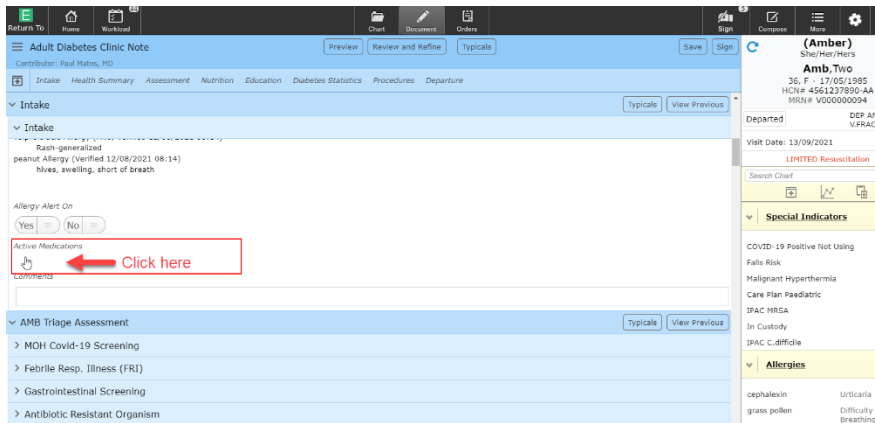

Accession Medication Reconciliation screen through your Document

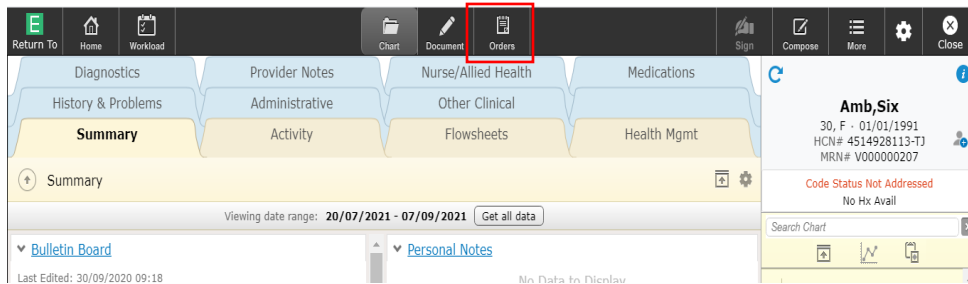
While documenting within the Intake Document Section, click on the open area below the Active Medications heading.

Manage Medications Screen

If the patient has active meds they will display on the left side of the screen. Review meds and click confirm – it's best practice that each medication is confirmed individually, rather than clicking the “confirm all” button.
