The top of the overlay shows the date that the documentation is was done, and who documented it. The white arrow on the right and left of the date of the document is to change which date's document you are viewing.

To recall the information into the current document you would click on "Recall" on the top right of the overlay. This will pull the information you see in the overlay into your current document.

After you recall information into the document, you are able to edit or change the information to suit current visit, i.e., goal changed from created to re assessed, or achieved. You are able to add more information to the document or remove information that is not pertinent for the current visit.
