



# **Medical Imaging Tip Sheet**



- From the Expanse desktop log in with your AD user name and password
- Select Ancillary >Imaging>Technologist Desktop
- Select site and then select department









#### From the IDM Worklist:

- Functions used for IDM procedures (modify/view/record exam)
  - Note- second screen at bottom of the screen provides key patient information
    - Pregancy
    - Hx of falls
    - Special Indicators
    - WTIS Information
- EMR (Electronic Medical Record) viewing of patient data (one exception Summary panel for viewing and entering data)
- PCS (Patient Care System) for entering documentation





#### When highlighted on the patient- the header will display patient information

- Name, age, sex, date of birth
- Code status and Allergies
- Height weight BSA BMI
- Account and MRN numbers
- Under the "i" is more information



The "i" also has the RAD Patient header information such as order/patient/Icoation information








The flags at the end of the technologist desktop "I" contain order information and any Special Indicators that may be on the patient chart




#### **PCS (Patient Care System) for documentation**




#### Clicking on PCS will bring you to the Worklist

- From the worklist you can add individual interventions such as Vital signs or MI Nuclear Medicine documentation or you can add a SOC for Medical Imaging (Standard of Care) which is a group of interventions that can be used for documentation.
- To add an intervention from the worklist click on Add at the bottom of the page
- Click on Name or Any Word then at the search prompt enter MI- this will bring you to a list of all of the
  available MI interventions to document on. Click on the one you want to document and then click on
  Save at the bottom of the screen






Alternatively you can add a Standard of Care by clicking on Standards of Care. Type in MI – highlight the SOC for Medical Imaging and click on it. This will select the item. Click on Save to add the SOC to the patient's chart.




Once interventions are added to the patient's worklist- they appear under the care item.

The question mark column shows protocols or associated data such as labs that will display when clicked on To document on an intervention – click on the NOW cell beside the intervention



#### **Documenting on the Intervention**

- There are several types of question types or queries
  - o Yes/No
  - Comments or text box
  - Multiple choice (one answer or several)
  - Date and times
  - Numbers
  - Instance types- allow you to select an answer (example IV site) document and then add another instance (example 2<sup>nd</sup> IV site)
- Document on the intervention and then save






#### **Entering Notes**



Focused Notes allow you to enter information not captured in the interventions on the worklist. For example a note might include information communicated to a physician about a change in condition of the patient under your care and the response


#### Click on Write Note

#### Data Formats – information that can be pulled into the note



Sign off the note with your PIN – note is saved. Notes can be removed or edited.
