Diet Order in Meditech Expanse: It is vital for all healthcare professionals, including nurses and physicians to select/order/enter appropriate diets for patients to enhance patient safety and care.

For the safety of our patients, the Meditech Expanse has adopted new ways of describing foods and drinks names, which are created on the basis of International Dysphagia Diet Standardization Initiative (IDDSI).

Solid	• Easy to Chew	 Softer, tender textured foods. Includes crustless bread.
Name Mnemonic Easy to Chew TXETC Soft and Bite Sized TXSFT Minced and Moist TXMIN Pureed TXPUR	Soft and Bite Sized	 Soft, tender foods. Size of food pieces designed to minimize choking risk (no bread). Chewing re- quired.
Pureea	Minced and Moist	• Soft and moist, minced. No bread.
	• Pureed	• Smooth textured foods with no lumps and usually eaten with a spoon. No chewing required.
Liquid Name Mnemonic Mildly Thick MILD Moderately Thick MOD	 Mildly Thick (formerly nectar like consistency) Moderately Thick	 Are sippable and pour quickly from a spoon but slower than thin liquids. Have a smooth texture with no lumps, fibers or seeds and can be drank from a cup or taken with a Spoon.

IMPORTANT TERMS AND DEFINITIONS TO UNDERSTAND IDDSI

- **Specialty Diet Requests** is a mandatory field where you select diet, such as regular, cardiac, and diabetic etc.
- Other fields are not mandatory; however, if a patient is experiencing or having difficulty chewing food then selecting a solid food texture, such as Easy to Chew or Soft and Bite Sized is important.
- Similarly, selecting a correct consistency of drinks/liquids, such as mildly or moderately thick is also important for the safety of patients with swallowing difficulty.
