**\*New\* Transitioning to standardized language for diet textures**

\*New\* International Dysphagia Diet Standardisation Initiative (IDDSI)

- Solid Texture
  - Regular = Regular
  - Easy to Chew = Softer foods includes bread
  - Soft and Bite Sized = Chopped no bread
  - Minced and Moist = Minced no bread
  - Pureed = Pureed
- Liquid Consistency
  - Mildly Thick = Nectar Thick
  - Moderately Thick = Honey Thick
  - Extremely Thick = Pudding Thick
