CTAS level Indicator

• Colour coded acc. to CTAS level as assigned at triage

Room ▼ Age/Sex RV Room/Age & Sex/Repeat Visits Indicator

- Top Indicator: Room number, may be colour coded as to what area pt is assigned to
- Middle Indicator: Age and Sex, colour coded pink for females, blue for males
- Bottom Indicator: Repeat visit number

Patient Name Chief Complaint Special Indicators Patient Name/Chief Complaint/Special Indicators

- Top Indicator: Patient name-Last name, First name
 - Yellow Highlighted if similar name alert
- Middle Indicator: Chief Complaint based on CEDIS Complaint as assigned at triage
- Bottom Indicator: Special Indicators I.e. In Custody, Falls Risk, Malignant Hyperthermia, Care Plans, Hearing/Vision Assist etc.

C F R Confidential/ Falls/Potential Reactive Behaviour Indicators

- C- "Y" for Confidential Patient
- F- "F" for Falls Risk
- R- "R" for Potential Reactive Behaviour (assigned and filled out in the Special Indicators)

Physician MRP Nurse Physician/MRP/Nurse Indicator

- Top Indicator: ED Physician last name
- Middle Indicator: Most Responsible Physician after admission/ED Physician consults with them
- Bottom Indicator: Assigned Nurse first name

Surveillance Indicator

- Surveillance Indicator, at present will include COVID screening and test results
- May be used in future for Catheter Associated Urinary Tract Infections (CAUTI) or Sepsis

Q ACK Acknowledge Indicator

- Indicator to acknowledge orders
- Ack-Med has medications that are ordered
- Stat shows when there are STAT orders



APPTS Outpatient Appointment to be made Indicator

- Indicates when a MD orders a Post Discharge Follow Up Clinic/Office Appointment Booking
- Reminds staff to complete the order/appointment information

Uncollected Indicator

Reminder to collect specimens that lab may not collect

*Abnormal/Critical Lab Results Indicator

- "A" for Abnormal results
- "C" for Critical results

Laboratory, Blood-bank and Microbiology Indicator

- Tan Background: specimen(s) ordered, nurse to collect specimen(s)
- Plain Background: specimen(s) ordered, lab to collect specimen(s)
- Blue Background: specimen(s) received
- Green Background: specimen(s) results completed

RAD CT US Radiology, Cat Scan and Ultrasound Indicator

- Plain Background: test is ordered
- Blue Background: test is taken
- Green Background: test is dictated

P S Prep/Send Indicators

- P- Indicator when CT/US put in requests for pre-test prep
- S- Indicator to send patient for appropriate test
- Black Circular arrows show prep to be completed
- Grey Circular arrows show prep completed

ECG Indicator

Indicator that an ECG order is placed for the patient

10 TAR Transfusion Administration Record Indicator

 Will tell when the units are Ready, Issued, Transfusing etc. and what the units are i.e. Packed Cells, Winrho (Rhogam) etc

PREC Additional Precautions Indicator

 documented from Triage Assessment or the Additional Precautions assessment (i.e. Droplet/Contact, Contact, Airborne etc.)

Admit Request Indicator

- Admit Request placed by the physician
- CDU Request placed by the physician

Best Possible Medication History (BPMH) Indicator

- BPMH requested by nursing staff
- BPMH in progress by Pharmacy
- BPMH completed by Pharmacy

Comment box/Communication Indicator

- Shows when there is a comment
- Not part of the actual chart
- Can be used to communicate with fellow staff members about the patient

LOS Time Status Event Time

Length of Stay Time/Current Status Event/Current Event Time Indicator

- Top Indicator: shows total Length of Stay (LOS)
- Middle Indicator: shows current Status event i.e. Received, Triaged, TBS, With MD, Admit, Ready for Discharge etc.
- Bottom Indicator: shows Length of Time in Current Status Event



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
