Unobtainable

- To enter Unobtainable, select the <Unobtainable> button
- This will prompt to document a rationale in the Comment field
- Update this prompt as soon as the information can be obtained $\ensuremath{\mathsf{NKA}}$
- To enter NKA, click the NKA button, this files as No Known Allergies in the EHR

Note

NKA and Unobtainable buttons only appear if there have been no previously entered allergies **New**

- The Allergen lookup is a type ahead lookup, meaning the more you type the smaller the list becomes when you select <Enter> to search
- Spelling is of great importance when searching an allergen
- Searching by short form or slang terminology will likely not yield any search results
 - Type is always Allergy
 - Severity should be Unknown unless the patient has a documented anaphylaxis, and this can be documented as Severe
 - o Status always defaults to Verified
 - \circ $\;$ Reaction is picked from the drop-down list
 - o Comment can be documented when needed

Entering Allergies not found in the Allergen Lookup - Uncoded Allergies

- Entering an allergen that is not contained in the allergen lookup will generate a warning that there are no matches in the system, and you are prompted to add the allergen as "Uncoded"
- Click on the Add as Uncoded button to add this allergen to the list
- The allergen will not be automatically cross checked with medications because it does not exist in the allergen dictionary

The allergen is not marked as Verified but rather as Uncoded

- The allergies file on the summary page in alphabetical order
- Clicking on the plus (+) sign will open a detail box per allergy

Editing Allergies

- If you need to edit an allergen, select the Edit button and choose the allergen you want to edit by highlighting it green
- Make the edits and save

Removing Allergies

- Checkmark the allergy or allergies to be removed
- Select remove from the footer buttons
- Enter reason why and include any pertinent comments, then save

Remove Verify Confirm

Note

Allergies maybe removed if entered in error on the patient's record or maybe removed after consultation with Pharmacist, Physician, Midwife or Nurse Practitioner

Confirming Allergies

- If a patient's allergies have been documented at a previous visit the allergies should be confirmed with the patient, then use the Confirm routine to update the EHR
 - Select the Edit button
 - o Checkmark all allergies to be confirmed
 - o Click the Confirm footer button

Remove Verify Confirm
