

## CARE4 MODULE NAME: PCS / EDM / SUR

### End of Life

**Overview:** When a patient is approaching the end of life or has passed there are several interventions and processes that can be added to the patient worklist as interventions or as physician's order

#### MAID

- A referral ordered by physician to the MAID navigator will place the MAID checklist on the patient's worklist or it can be added as needed
- Physicians may also order a Consult to MAID assessor and/or Medications to be used for MAID

#### Trillium Gift of Life (TGLN)

- Physicians can enter order to notify TGL- this will appear as intervention on the patient's worklist or it can be added

Note – Care after death includes queries for TGL

- On admission in the Advanced Planning and SDM documentation - patients are asked regarding organ or tissue donation (asked on each admission)

#### Death

- Physicians can enter an order to permit Nurse to pronounce death

#### Nursing Workflow

- When a patient has passed add the Care after Death intervention to the patient's worklist, document
- Discharge Plan
  - Discharge Disposition – Select the most applicable disposition (Death in Facility, Medical Assist in Dying)
  - Expired Date/Time – Enter

After filing the disposition, expired date/time, the admission status updates to DIS INx
