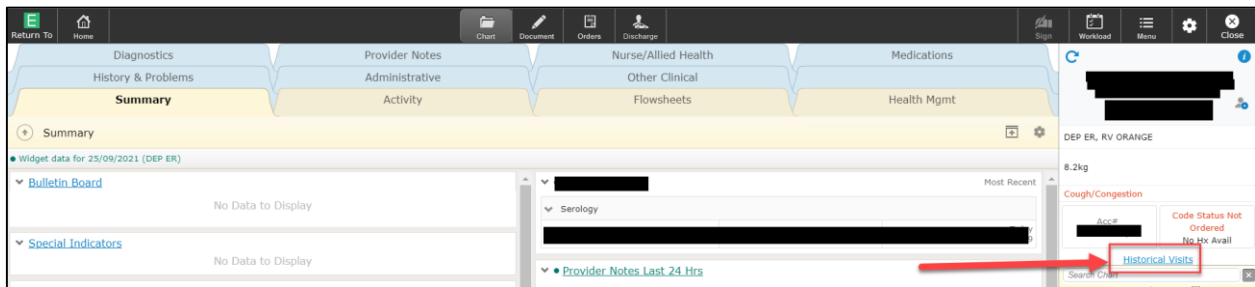

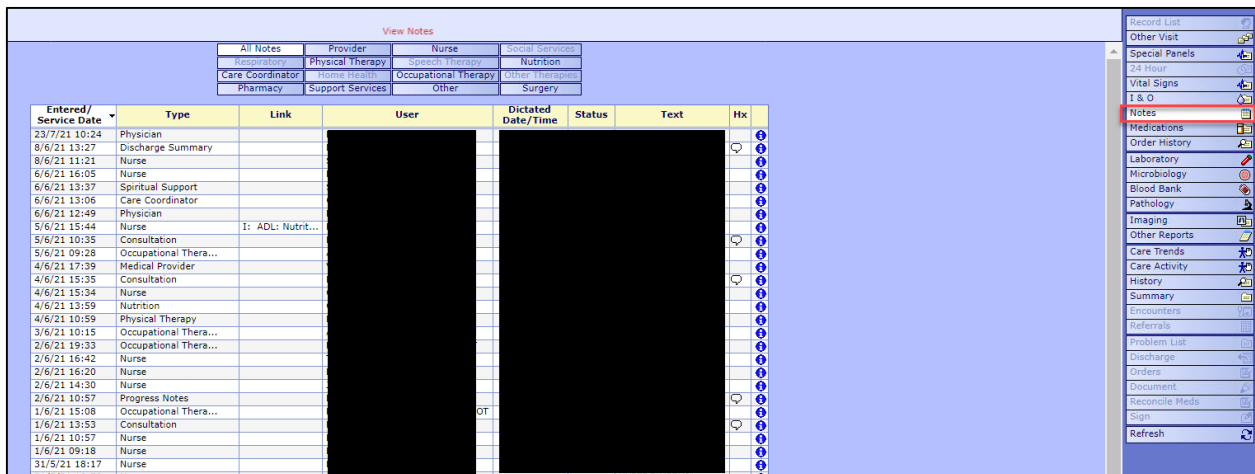
How to Access Historical Information

To access the historical link, physicians have two main options.

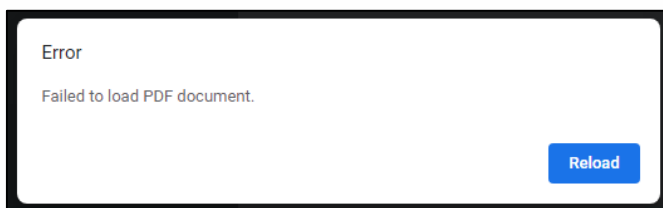
Currently, the historical link button under the patient's header prevents physicians from opening any document that is a PDF.



When this opens the old EMR, the physician navigates to the “Notes” section; Open any report



If any of the notes open a PDF, an error message is produced and you cannot access the information this way. There is fix from the vendor – MEDITECH – being implemented soon



To access patient information without getting an error – look for the information within the patient’s chart in. Click the filter on the right and select “5.x All Visits or 6.x All Visits”
