Expressed Breast Milk and Pasteurized Human Donor Milk Printing and Labelling

Overview

This document provides instruction on how to print and label Expressed Breast Milk (EBM) and Pasteurized Human Donor Milk (PHDM) for both storage and administration/scanning.

1.) To access the labels, follow the path below from the main menu in Expanse:

2.) Choose the label you wish to print based on patient status and active orders:

Expressed Breast Milk Labels for Administration

- for active EBM orders
- has patient identifiers and space for date/time pumped
- **BARCODED** for scanning at time of administration

Human Donor Milk Labels for Administration (RVH only)

- for active PHDM orders
- has patient identifiers for labelling decanted volume
- **BARCODED** for scanning at time of administration

Expressed Breast Milk Labels for NPO/Storing

- for NPO orders or families wishing to store EBM (ex. Obstetrical patients)
- has patient identifiers and space for date/time pumped
- NO BARCODE



Example Workflows:

Obstetrical patient wishing to store breast milk in communal fridge

- 1.) Access labels from the Expanse Main Menu and select "Expressed Breast Milk Labels for NPO/Storing"
- 2.) Enter patient identifier and click "OK" to search for patient

- 3.) Ensure labels are in printer.
- 4.) Provide labels to family ensure EBM is properly labelled before storing in communal fridge. Follow site policy for storing and releasing EBM. *labels will NOT have a bar code*



NICU – NPO to Feeding Initiation

- 1.) Acknowledge and review NPO order for patient.
- 2.) Access labels from the Expanse Main Menu and select "Expressed Breast Milk Labels for NPO/Storing"

3.) Enter patient identifier and click "OK" to search for patient **Account Number: type in FULL account number including all zeros (Ex: VN0001234/21)

- 4.) Ensure labels are in printer.
- 5.) Provide labels to family ensure EBM is properly labelled before storing in communal fridge. Follow site policy for storing EBM.
 labels will NOT have a bar code
- 6.) When ready provider discontinues NPO order and orders Neonate/Infant Diet including EBM order.
- 7.) Acknowledge and review new orders:
 - Neonate/Infant Diet order will contain instructions for feeding
 - Total Fluid Intake Order (if ordered)
 - EBM order will flow to eMAR*

11.) Ensure labels are in printer.

12.) Provide new labels to family and ask them to use these (WITH BARCODE) going forward.

13.) Replace any stored EBM in communal fridge/freezer with barcode labels, ensuring correct date/time pumped is transcribed.

- 6.) Use labels for patient specific PHDM volumes (in syringe, bottle, etc.) decanted from milk bank provided container for scanning at time of administration. Follow site policy for documentation related to PHDM.
