Overview

View information from 1-24 hours in the future.

Use the check boxes to list interventions, outcomes, medications or regulatory items.

These symbols indicate the presence of associated data, protocol, or related text information. Click to edit the item details.

The status and any next or past due time appear. Click the status row to change the status. For outcomes, click the time row to reschedule. Note: "Active" does not appear. No status assumes Active.

Click table cells to select items for documentation.

⏰ appears for scheduled items.

Click the Last Done column to view the item history.

Icons appear in the first column to indicate the type of care item. Assessment = A, Intervention = I, Medication = M, Outcome = O, Regulatory = R, Launch Routine = L.

View or edit interventions or outcomes.

Enter an incident via Risk Management.

Add more care items to the treatment plan.

Enter a reason that an item was not performed.

Capture data from a monitor interface.

The icons in the left column of the screen may also appear as Ao (Orderable Assessments) or Io (Orderable interventions), you will be able to click on the **I** symbol to view the information from the order.

If an intervention is prefixed with ORD that indicates that there must be an order from the Most Responsible Provider on the patient's chart. Do not add these to your worklist.
