eMAR Independent Double Check and Co-Signature Medications

Step 1 Sign in to Meditech Expanse

Step 2 Chose patient from your status board or locate patient through lists (location, find account etc).

Step 5 Verify patient by scanning wristband/barcode – once verified this will appear in patient header
