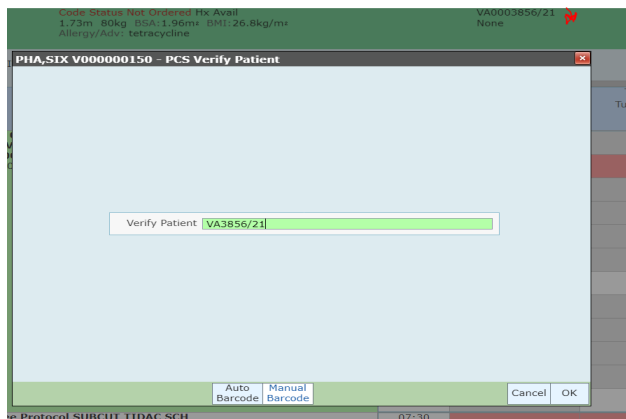


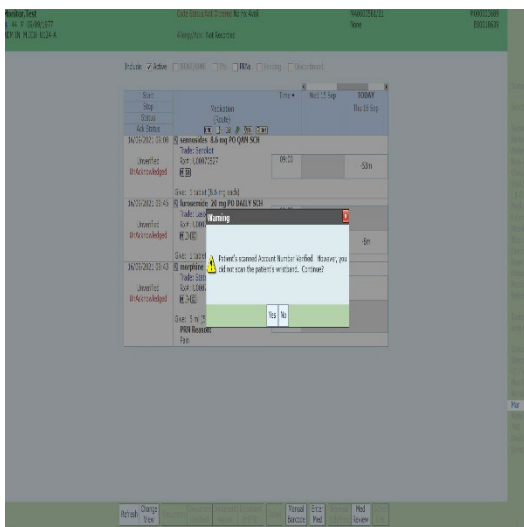
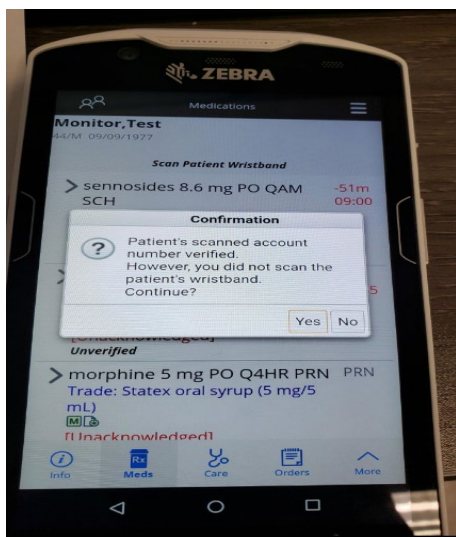
## CARE4 MODULE NAME: PCS (eMAR)

### eMAR – Manual Barcode if Armband/Medication Barcodes Do Not Scan

If scanning patient's armband unsuccessful due to armband condition – and there is no ability to print another– nurse can use DOCUMENT eMAR and select MANUAL BARCODE and enter the patients account number. **\*\*THIS IS PRACTICE FOR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES ONLY AND CAN/WILL BE AUDITED – HAVING AN ARMBAND IN PLACE IS AN INTERGRAL PART OF PATIENT SAFETY\*\***



If attempting to scan instead of armband (IF ARMBAND NOT SCANNABLE) – warnings will appear (CAN BE AUDITED)



If **MEDICATIONS** cannot be scanned - manual barcode can be used as well. Nurses would enter the **RX #** Pharmacy should be notified if meds cannot be scanned. **\*\*THIS IS PRACTICE FOR EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES AND CAN/WILL BE AUDITED\*\***
