Diet Protocol and ERAS

Overview: In Expanse physicians are able to order a protocol that allows other care providers to order appropriate diets for patients based on criteria (see table below).

Physicians can also order a specific diet order if required.

For example, order a sodium reduced diet, or have specific requirements on a diabetic diet which are not covered in the protocol.

The four options available are Diabetic Diet, Heart Healthy Diet, Regular and Renal – all of which can be modified to include the desired requirements.
