

CARE4 MODULE NAME: CARE4 Tip Sheet ONCE One meds (Difference between schedule and direction)

Overview

This document includes recommendations on how to order “ONCE & ONE” orders outside of an order set.

Best Practice & Easiest Way

If a required “ONCE & ONE” order is not in an order set or not found in the look-up, the order can be edited.

The **easiest way** is to click on the **frequency** field, and edit the frequency to “ONCE”.
