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### Hourly Rounds Completed -

- No Needs Identified by the patient or family at this time
- Patient Restful with Eyes Closed
- Needs identified and charted in Documentation

### Beginning of Shift

- Patient Identifiers in Place
  - Allergy wristband in place
  - Patient wristband in place
  - Falls wristband in place
- Visual Checks
  - Falls Identifier in place per facility policy
  - Isolation Signage
  - Oxygen Operational
  - Suction Equipment checked and operational
  - Wandering Identifier in Place

### Documentation

- Patient Reports **Pain** is Controlled
- **Personal and toileting needs met**
- change of **Position** for patient either with assistance or patient moves self
- Hourly visual checks
  - Bed Alarm on
  - Call Bell in Reach
  - Floor clear of Obstacles, Dry and Clean
  - Mobility Aids Easily Accessible
  - Personal Alarm On as required - Wanderguard in Place, Wandering Identifier in Place
  - **Personal Items within Reach**
  - Suction and Oxygen operational
- Bed Position and Side Rails
  - Bed in Lowest Position
  - Brakes on
  - Side Rails - #up with Documentation of Restraint Intervention if ALL siderails are up
- Patient Location on Rounds
  - Bed
  - Chair
  - Geri-Chair
  - Off Unit
  - Out on Pass
  - Wheelchair
  - Other
- Patient Activity Observed
  - Ambulating on Unit
  - Ambulating in Room
  - Washroom
  - Resting Eyes Closed
  - Restless or Fidgeting
  - Independent activity - TV, reading, computer/phone etc
  - With visitors
  - Other
- Anything Else Observed with comment or patient requests
