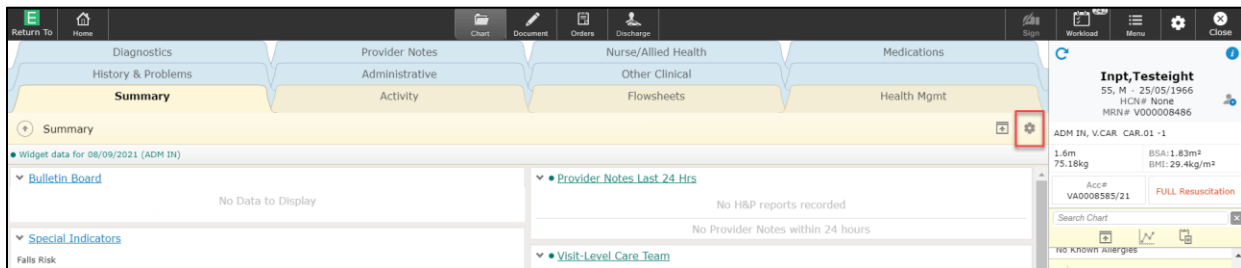
Overview

Activities of Daily Living documentation can be found in several places within Web Acute / Web ED.

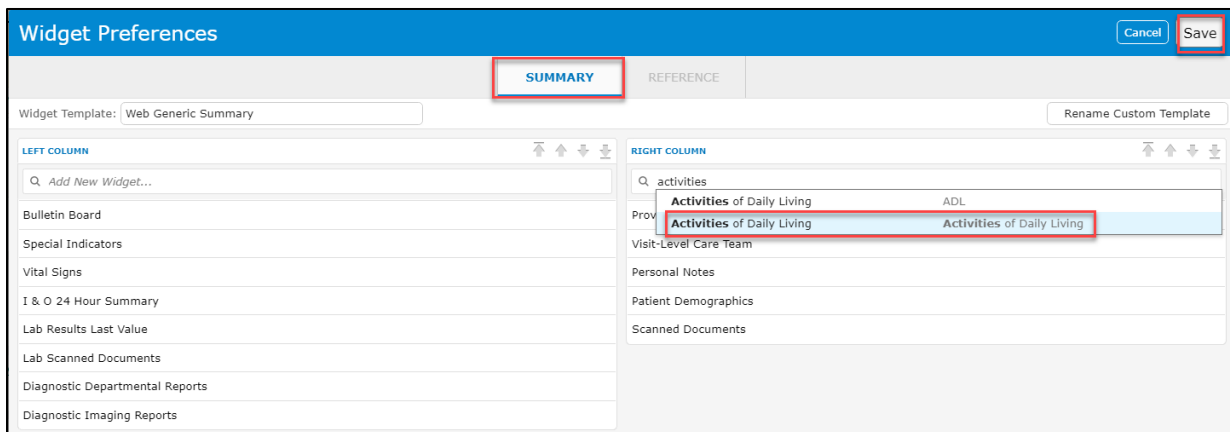
- Option 1 – Through the **new** Activities of Daily Living Widget

Option 1 – Through the new Activities of Daily Living Widget

Click the Gear Icon to add the Activities of Daily Living Widget



In the **Summary** tab, click the column that you want to add the widget, then search for “**Activities of Daily Living**”. Choose the **SECOND OPTION**. Then click **Save**
