#### Overview:

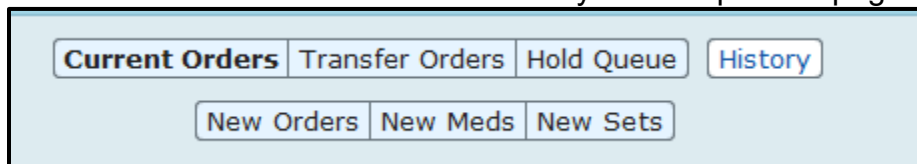
There are times when it may be necessary to print a paper copy of an order as a reference for new orders. Example- complex wound care from a previous visit

#### Follow these steps:

From the status board locate the correct patient account that you want to print the order from and Open the Chart

### Indications/Contraindions

Indications for Selected NPWT Type	<p>This product is indicated for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>patients with chronic, acute, traumatic, sub-acute and dehisced wounds, partial-thickness burns, ulcers (such as diabetic, pressure, and venous insufficiency), flaps, and grafts.</li> <li>It may also be used for the temporary bridging of abdominal wall openings where primary closure is not possible and/or repeat abdominal entries are necessary.</li> <li>It may also be used for management of surgical incisions that continue to drain following closure.</li> </ul>
Contraindications for Selected NPWT Type	<p>Do not use negative pressure wound therapy if there is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>known malignancy in the wound,</li> <li>untreated osteomyelitis,</li> <li>non-enteric and unexplored fistulas, or</li> <li>necrotic tissue with eschar present</li> </ul>
