To enhance communication between care providers and between care providers and physicians new tools are being introduced for use



The Bulletin Board is for communication purposes only. Any comments or information entered in the Bulletin Board will not be uploaded to or accessible via the eChart application.



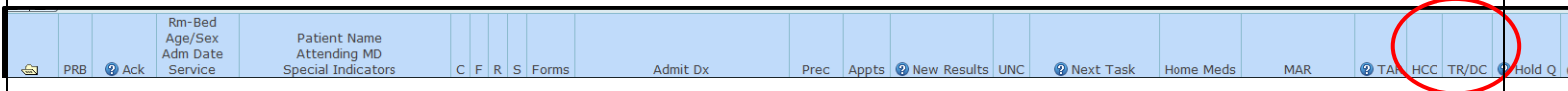
In PCS
