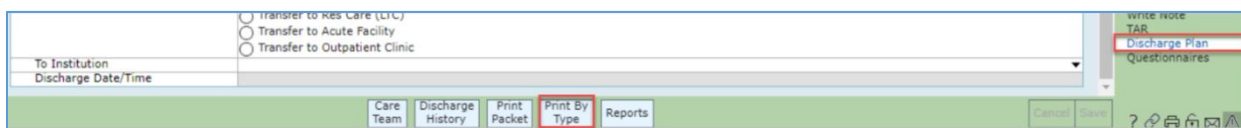
Topic: Printing Home Medication Report from Discharge Plan

Overview:

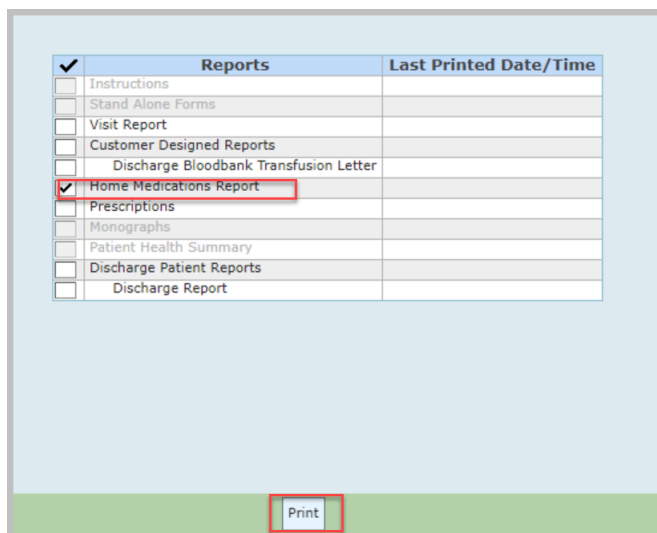
On discharge, the physician completes discharge medication reconciliation, and prescriptions if required. The physician prints the prescription and signs. Nursing documents the discharge assessment which includes specific information for the patient on discharge. Nursing prints the discharge packet to give to the patient. The discharge packet includes the discharge medication reconciliation and new prescriptions. The home medication report can be printed from within the discharge plan to fax to the retail pharmacy.

Printing

1. Status board, highlight the patient
2. Open chart
3. Select Discharge Plan routine
4. Select Print By Type in the footer buttons



5. Select Home Medications Report
6. Select Print in the footer buttons

If the report is greyed out, the physician needs to complete/finalize the discharge medication reconciliation and prescriptions if applicable
