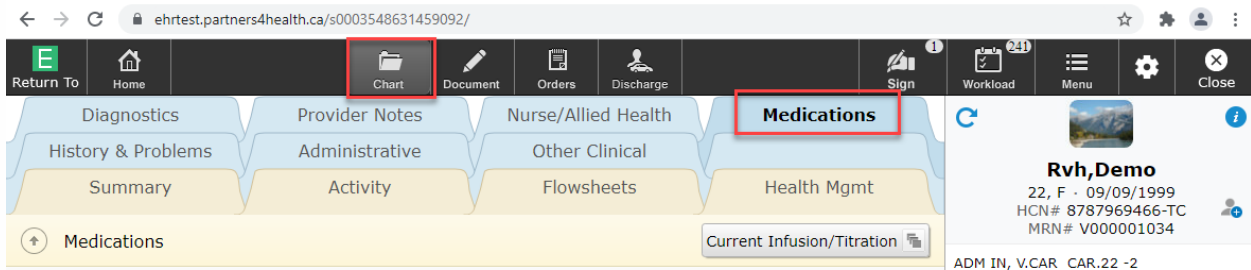
## Viewing Read-only eMAR

### Overview

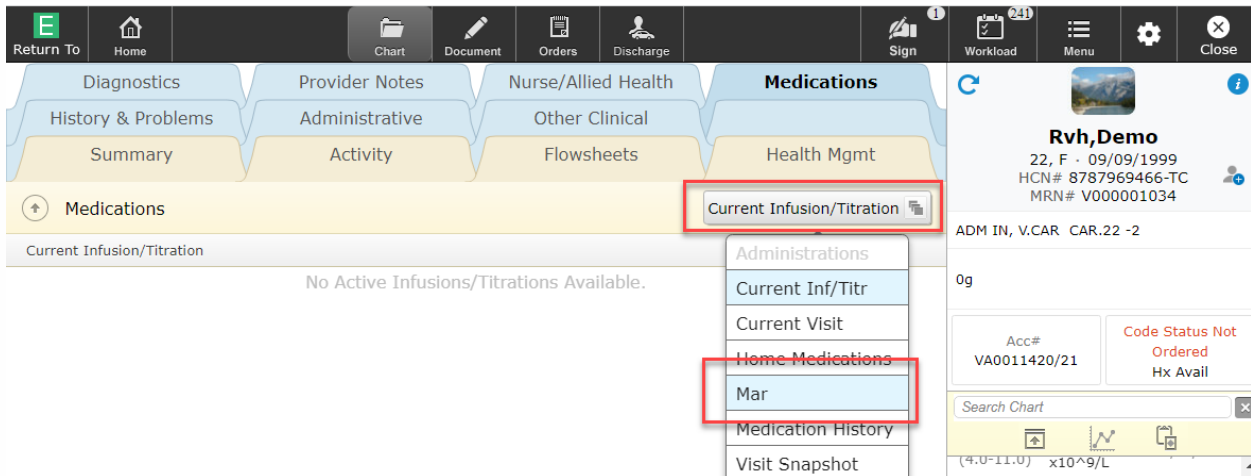
This document provides instructions on how to access a view-only eMAR within Expanse to identify medication administrations.

### Accessing eMAR

- In the Chart tab, select the Medications folder.



- To view the eMAR, we need to change the current view/filter. Select the grey box in the top right of the Medication screen (image below says Current Infusion/Titration). Then select Mar.



### Viewing eMAR

- Selecting Mar will produce a read-only view of the Mar and show which medication administrations are scheduled, completed, or not given with specified reason.

- Selecting a specific medication and pressing Detail in the bottom footer will produce additional information, such as medication detail, order detail, and flowsheet data.
